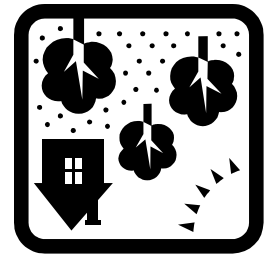

Plant and Pest Update

November 15, 2007

The 2007 growing season brought many insect concerns to gardeners in the Stateline area. In some areas of Southern Wisconsin, homeowners were plagued with the problem of Japanese beetle. Other places suffered from infestations of gypsy moth. And all along the Stateline area we live in the shadow of the destructive and costly Emerald Ash Borer just miles away.

If these were not enough, the ongoing dry weather we encounter each year introduces a level of stress into our trees and shrubs that invites in additional insect pests.

With so many problems at hand—and others looming on the horizon—UW-Extension responds by offering green industry professionals and interested public the opportunity to learn more about insect related issues of southern Wisconsin and northern Illinois by attending our November 15 program.

UW-Extension specialists will be on hand that afternoon to discuss the issues of Emerald Ash Borer, Japanese beetle, gypsy moth, and insects associated with drought stress on our woody plants:
