

**Border Bed A****Garden #5**

This large planting space features a transition of color throughout the growing season and has interest for the entire year. Anchored by an ornamental pear tree and three colorful crabapples, this space is filled with spring blooming bulbs in April and May and is then planted with thousands of showy annuals that will last thru September. This space is then utilized as part of our Holiday Lights Show and features lit, botanical displays. This border bed is along a primary path and viewed by all visitors.
