The Entrance Garden is essentially the “front door” to Rotary Gardens, a vital area of interest for development and maximization of ornamental appeal. All visitors to the garden come through this area featuring large flower beds adjacent to the main road (Palmer Drive) and seen as well by hundreds of every day passing motorists. This garden space includes two parking lot islands, it’s western border and huge front flowering berm. The parking lot islands contain trees, perennials and over 8000 daffodils (Narcissus) representing 300 varieties. This area is also punctuated by antique lamps that originally adorned the Janesville Monterey Bridge.
